## Quality Assurance Certification Program

- Established to ensure Marine Corps uniform items and accessories manufactured for sale through the Marine Corps Exchange (MCX) and designated Retail Clothing Outlets meet USMC requirements and standards
- Marine Corps uniform items and accessories may be found in the United States Marine Corps Regulation (MCO P1020.34G) located at <http://www.marcorsyscom.usmc.mil/sites/mucb/>
- Criteria for Participation
  - All Marine Corps Officer items that do not have a national stock number (NSN) and meet or exceed base specification requirements
  - Enlisted items that exceed base specification requirements and are not under DLA contract



## Quality Assurance Certification Program

- The Marine Corps Exchanges and designated Retail Clothing Outlets are provided a Marine Corps Approved Source List
- Certifications are valid for 3 – 5 years depending on product category
- Certification numbers are included on garment labels to indicate an item is authorized



GARMENT MFGD OF U.S.M.C. APPROVED  
MATERIALS FOR STYLE DESIGN AND QUALITY  
TO LIKE ITEM APPROVED BY U.S.M.C. SERIAL:

- Certification numbers are site specific and unique to each manufacturer and associated subcontractor
- Manufacturing facilities are subject to inspection and certification can be revoked for non-compliance


