PROJECT INTRODUCTION:

The Technology and Human System Integration Program will provide an effective technology assessment and transfer process by which the US Army Natick Soldier RD&E Center (NSRDEC) can respond to the growing technology needs of the Department of Defense/ Homeland Defense (DoD/ HLD) mission and Homeland Security (HLS) Operations. This program will design a mechanism and forum to foster multi-agency driven research, development, test and evaluation efforts, where technologies and/or integrated systems have not yet met the criteria for technology transfer or commercialization.

OBJECTIVE:

- To identify and prioritize high return on investment technologies to meet the goals set in PL 107 Section 1401
- Define a technology transfer process
- Define user requirements as they relate to current technology, including prioritization and trade-off analysis.


